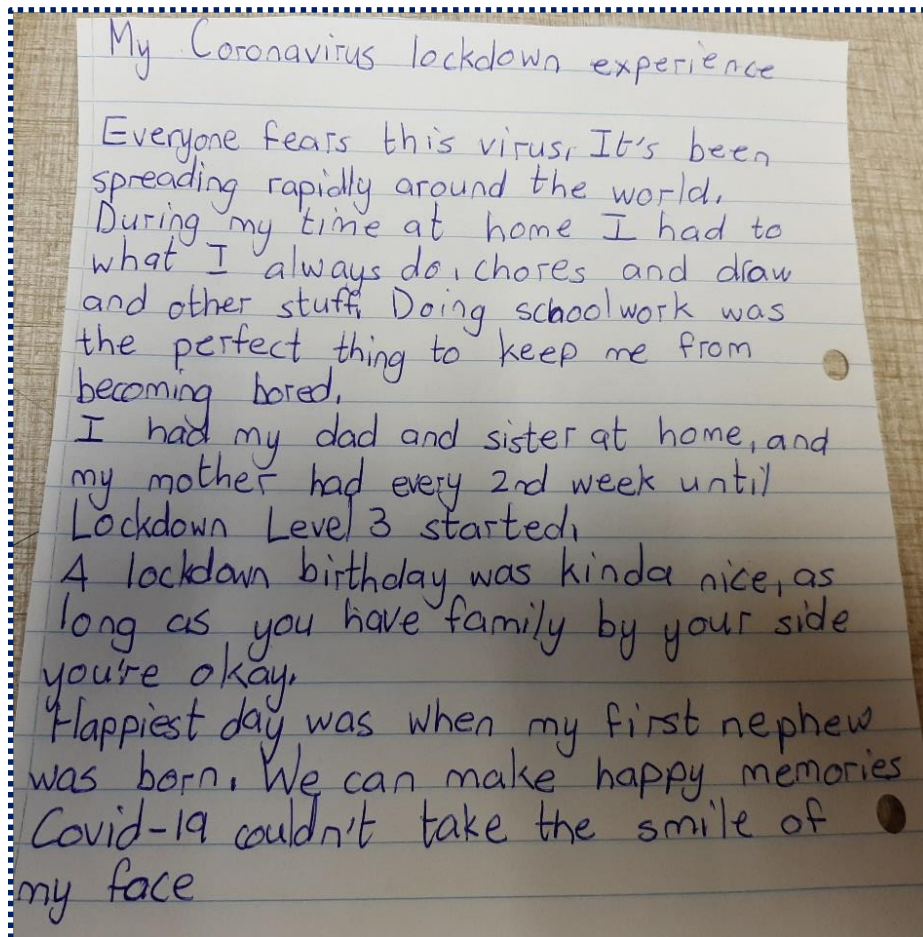


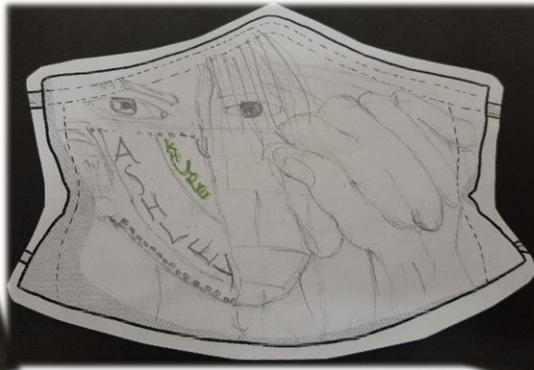


Hello Everyone and here is our third edition of the

Since the lockdown has started. Now everything is going bad. people are dying from Coronavirus, they is too much poverty Gender based violence is getting worse.

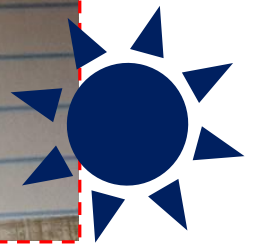
Now the grade 7 and 12 have opened schools

2) Most infected people in develop mild to moderate illness and recover without hospitalization. It lives on surface 2 hours to 9 days.

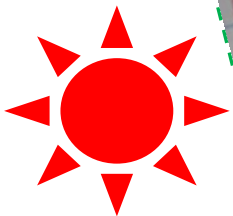
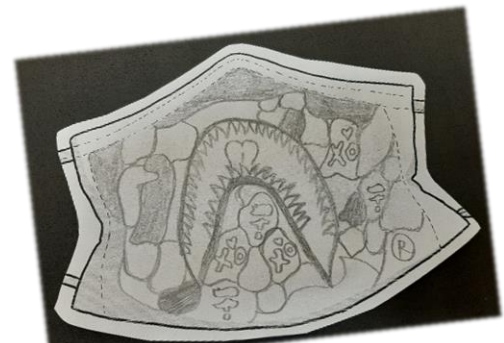
3) Social distancing is very important. It's protects us from getting the virus.

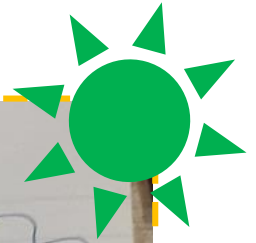
4) A quarantine is a restriction on the movement of people and goods which is intended to prevent the spread of disease

day!

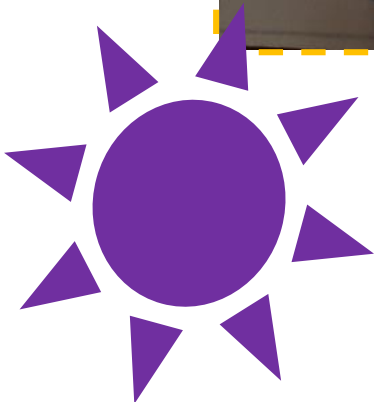
A virus broke out,

Coronavirus

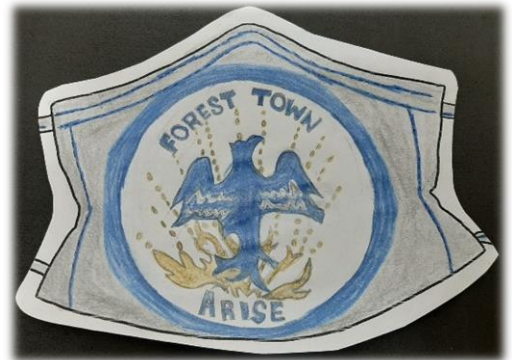
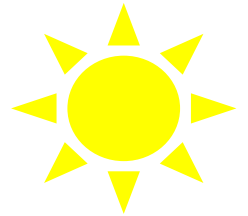
