4. ALL LEARNERS TURNING 18 IN 2025

Parents please note that in the year that your child turns 18, he/she needs to leave the school at the end of the year. It is the parents' responsibility to find alternative placement for their child.

5. GRADE 7 LEARNERS IN 2025

Learners completing Grade 7 this year, have to leave the school at the end of 2025. It is the Districts' responsibility to find alternative placement for your child. You will have to work with Forest Town School to submit relevant documentation to the District.

6. LEARNERS IN WEP

At the age of 18 they will have to exit the school at the end of that year. The learner will be included in an EXIT programme during the year. It is the parents' responsibility to communicate with their child's class teacher and the Occupational Therapy Department regarding their child's exit strategy.

7. EARLY ARRIVAL OF LEARNERS

Please be reminded that learners will only be supervised at the drop off point in Cowie Road from 7am. Staff begin their duty punctually and parents and drivers are to remain with the learner/ward till 7am. The parent or person dropping off the learner before 7am, will held liable for the safe-keeping of the learner till then.

10. FOREST TOWN SCHOOL BECOMING A CASHLESS ENVIRONMENT

Forest Town School will not accept cash payments anymore. Please do not send cash with a learner or driver anymore. Please use one of the following methods:

- FNB ATM deposit make sure to send proof of payment to the school immediately.
- EFT make sure to send proof of payment to the school immediately.
- Speed point facility is available at the school for card payments.
- Pay Fast is also available on the schools' website.

11. SCHOOL UNIFORM

11.1 GENERAL DRESS CODE

- The school uniform (below) must be adhered to. This is determined by the School Governing Body.
- No blazer, only navy blue anoraks.
- No jewellery except Medic alert bracelets, wristwatch and "sleeper" earrings (silver or gold) for girls only. One per ear, no reeds.
- No fancy headgear.
- No coloured tights.
- No sports or running shoes. (Any special footwear to be discussed with the therapists.)
- No colouring of hair is allowed.
- ♦ Boys hair must be neat and short no touching of the shirt collar. Fringes may not touch the eyes.
- Girls long hair is to be tied up with white or navy blue ribbons/bands or baubles. Fringes may not touch the eyes.
- All clothing, as well as shoes, must be clearly marked with the child's name.
- No necklaces or thin neck chains will be allowed except for religious reasons. Please supply a letter to prove.
- No nail polish on finger nails or toe nails.
- ♦ Boys and girls during a normal school day, at an official school event and/or when wearing the school uniform, no visible tattoos are allowed. Learners will be expected to cover any such tattoos.

11.2 SUMMER SCHOOL UNIFORM FOR BOYS

 Grey shorts or long trousers, white short-sleeved shirts, plain grey jersey, black lace-up school shoes, long grey socks.

11.3 SUMMER SCHOOL UNIFORM FOR GIRLS

• Grey skirt, not higher than 5cm above the knee, white short-sleeved blouse, plain grey jersey, black bar and buckle shoes/lace-up shoes, short white socks.

11.4 HATS, TIES & TRACKSUITS

- Sun hats available from school at R35,00 each. Parents please make sure that your child has a hat to wear at school when they are outside on the playground.
- School ties available from school at R40,00 each. Compulsory from Grade 4 upwards.

School Fees for the year **2025** amounts to **R9 020.00** per annum. Below are the payment plan options available to suit the financial status of the parents.


